



Learning to Read Baby Qs

Come and explore how babies communicate their needs and feelings. Consistent primary care teachers can learn to recognize how each baby uses their body, facial expressions, eyes, and voice in generally consistent as well as unique ways. Anticipating the needs of an infant allows the care teacher to better support attachment, self regulation, identity formation, and a secure base for the infant to explore and learn.
