## Adverse Childhood Experiences (ACEs)



2.3 x Children in poverty are 2.3 times more likely to suffer from 3 or more ACEs. ACEs include abuse, neglect, homelessness, parental substance abuse, or foster care.

Research shows that as the number of ACEs increases, so does the risk of lifelong negative outcomes.

## Iowa's Head Start Workforce



**2,095** HS and EHS jobs in Iowa In Iowa, the average Head Start teacher with a bachelor's degree makes **\$31,257** per year, compared to an average kindergarten teacher salary of **\$51,140**.
